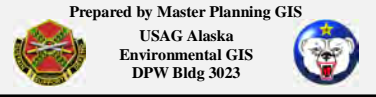
****All recreational users must exit training areas no later than 11:59 PM on the date prior to closure.**

How to Gain Recreational Access to Fort Wainwright Training Lands:

- 1. Obtain a Recreation Access Permit (RAP).** This can be obtained online or at one of our two kiosk locations: the Fort Wainwright Visitor Center, or the Fort Greely Visitor Center.
 - 2. Check-in by calling the USARTRAK automated phone system or go online.** This must be done before entering the training lands, and you will need your RAP number to access the system.
- This permit is free to all individuals, and required by those 16 years of age and older.
